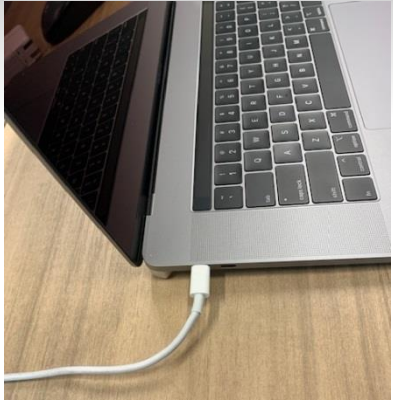

Connecting Devices



1. Laptop Charger



2. Video Conferencing Light



2a. Video Conferencing Light Attachment



3. USB Cable

1. Connect USB-C power supply to any USB-C port located on both sides of computer.
2. Attach the Video Conferencing Light to the back of laptop using the suction cup.
 - a. Ensure the engraved "Lume Cube" portion is facing the back of the computer.
 - b. ***IMPORTANT***: ensure suction cup is clean and free of any debris.
3. The Video Conference Light box contains a USB-C to USB-C cable. Connect cable to Lume Cube and any available USB-C ports on either side of laptop. Press and hold the blue power button to turn the device on.

6. Connecting USB mouse

5. Attach USB-C multi-port adapter to MacBook Pro.
6. Connect the USB Mouse to any USB port located on USB-C adapter.
7. Connect the Saramonic Lavalier microphone to any available port on USB-C adapter.

8. Connecting Logitech headset



All components connected

8. Connect Logitech H530 headset to any available port on USB-C multiport adapter, concluding all connections to laptop.

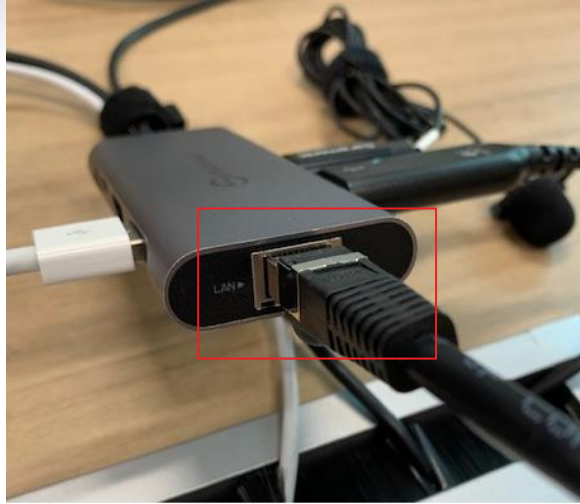

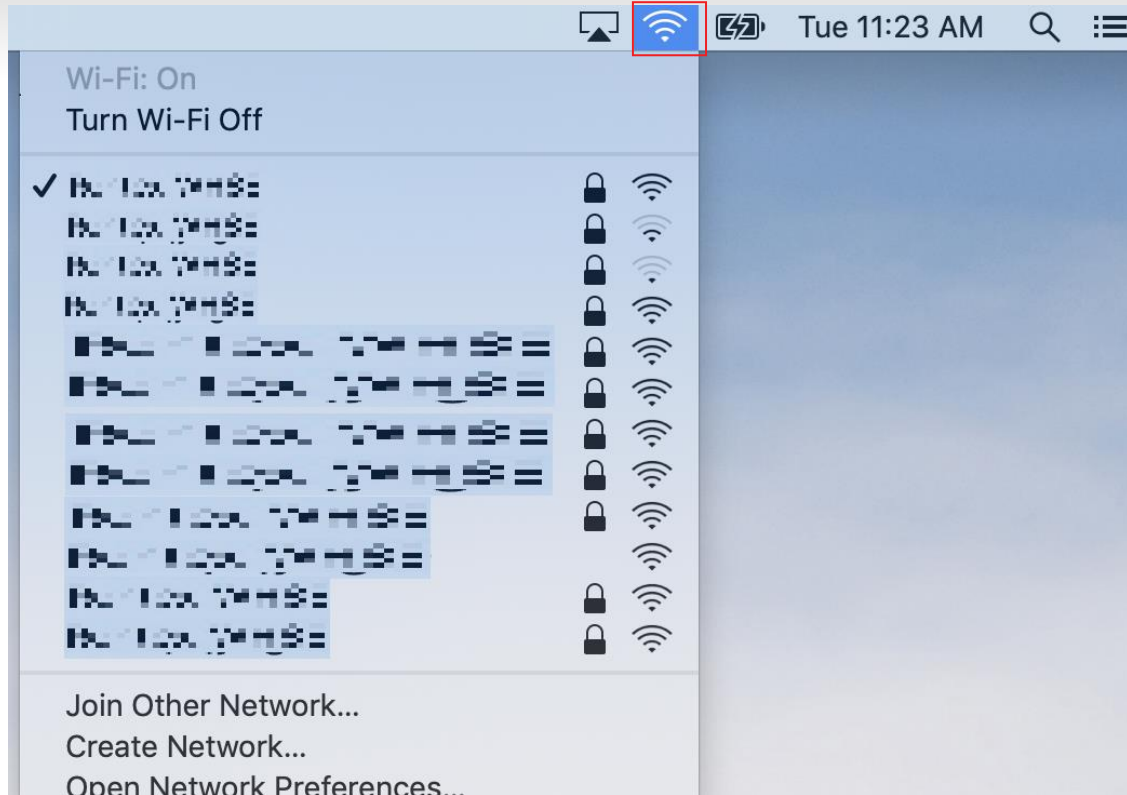
7. Powering the laptop on



8a. Connecting Ethernet Cable

7. Power on the computer by pressing power button located on the right upper corner of keyboard, and wait until macOS initializes. Press enter to login (no password).
8. Ensure the computer is connected to the Internet, by using one of the following methods: Ethernet or Wi-Fi.
 - a) Ethernet:
 - Plug the Ethernet cable to the LAN port located on USB-C adapter.
 - Please refer to your Internet Service Provider (ISP) for more information.

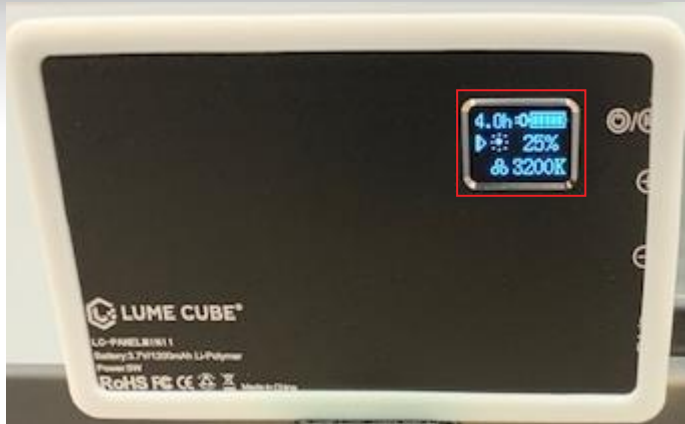

b) Wi-Fi Connection:

- Click on the Network icon located on the right upper corner of screen (next to the computer's clock) and choose your Wi-Fi network SSID name.
- Type your Wireless password in the network security key, if applicable.
 - Please refer to your Internet Service Provider (ISP) for further assistance.

Lume Cube Display



Adjust Brightness and Color

7. Use the blue and scroll buttons located at the right side of device to change the brightness and color warmth.
 - a) Brightness:
 - (21) adjustable options: starting at 1% up to 100% in increments of 5%.
 - b) Warmth:
 - (25) adjustable options: starting at 3200K (warm / tungsten) to 5600K (cool / daylight)

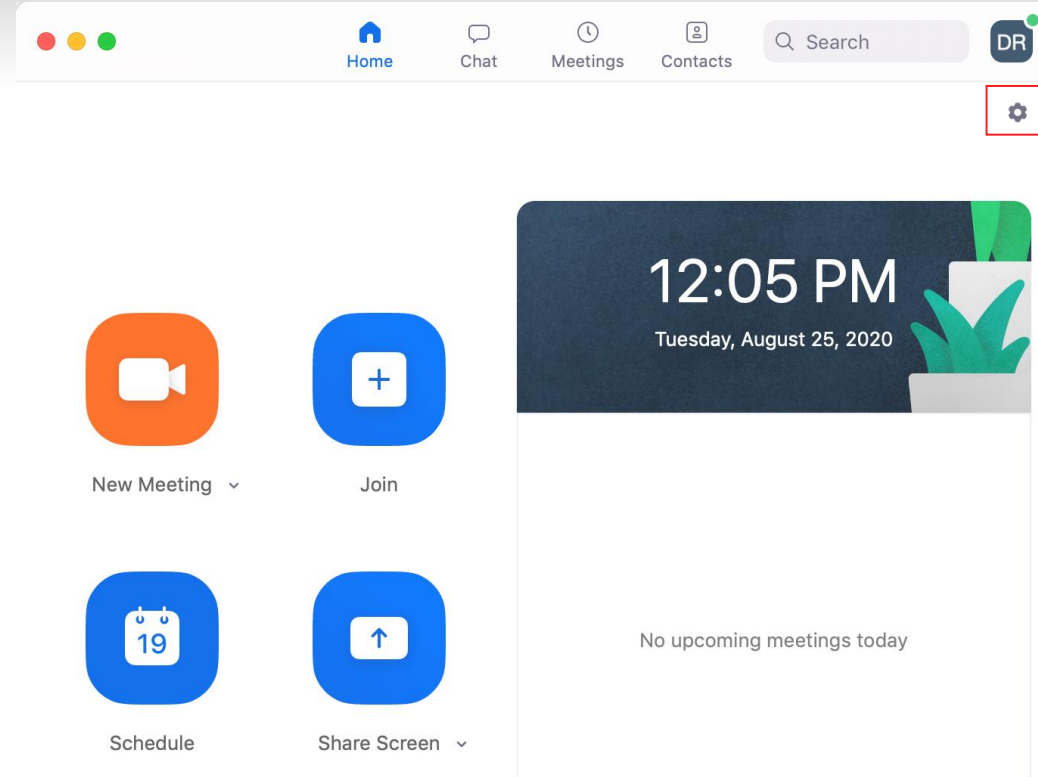

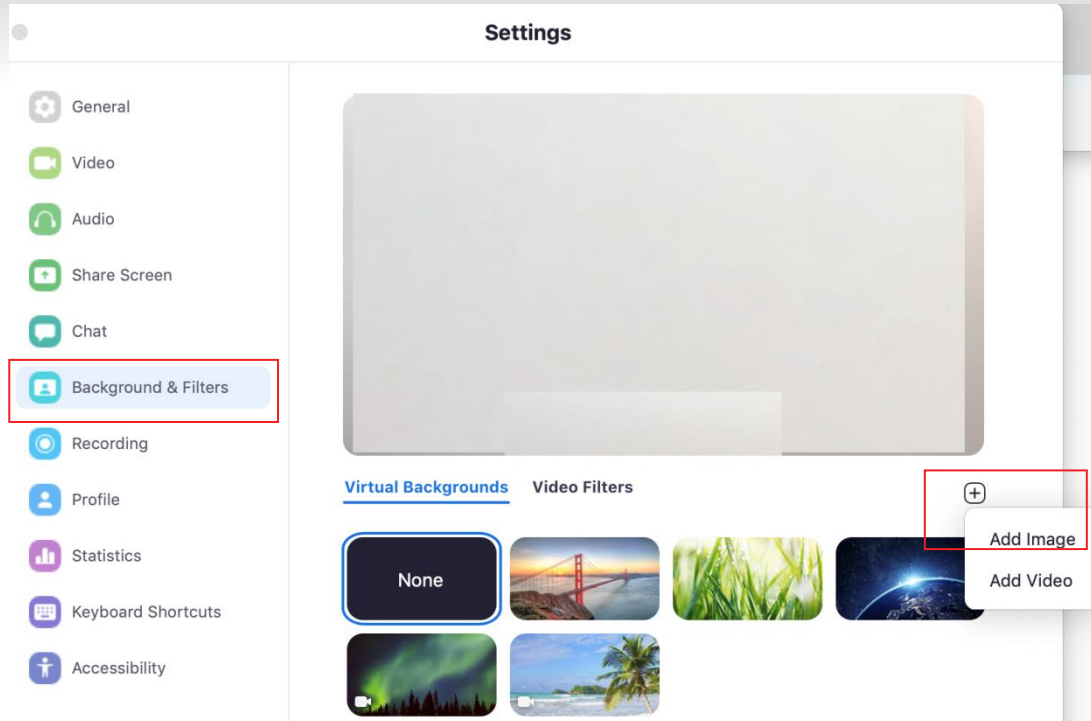

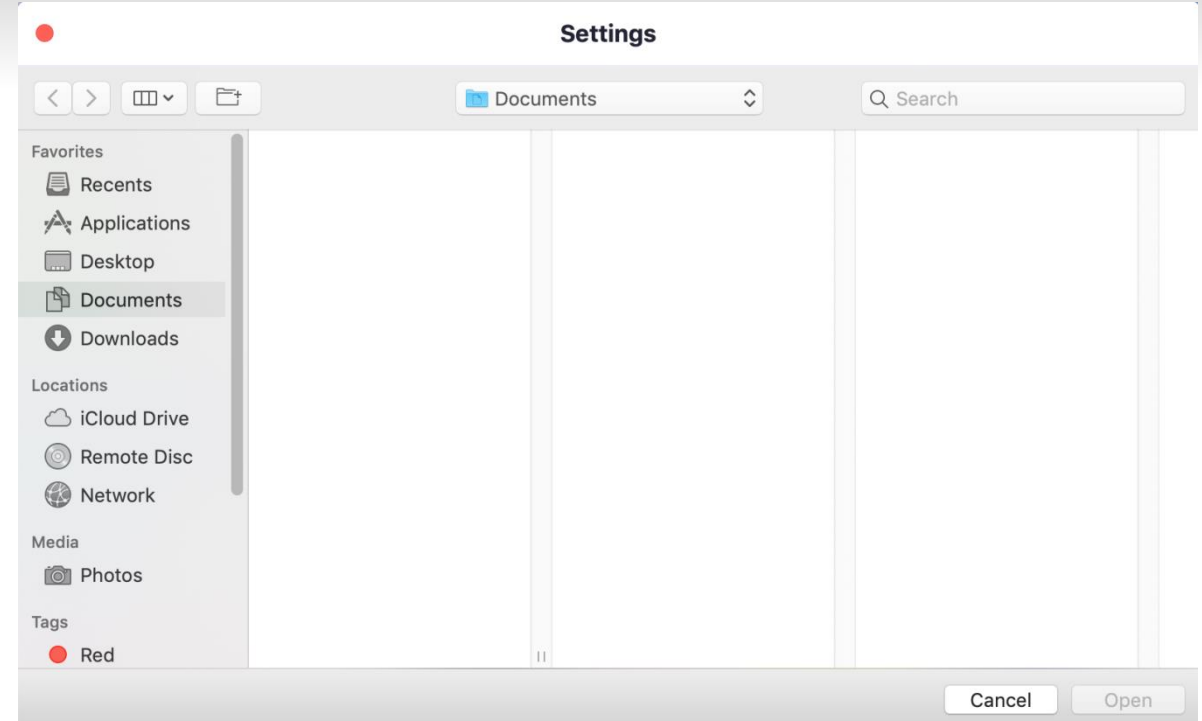


3. Click on the "Settings" (gear symbol)

Adding Zoom Background

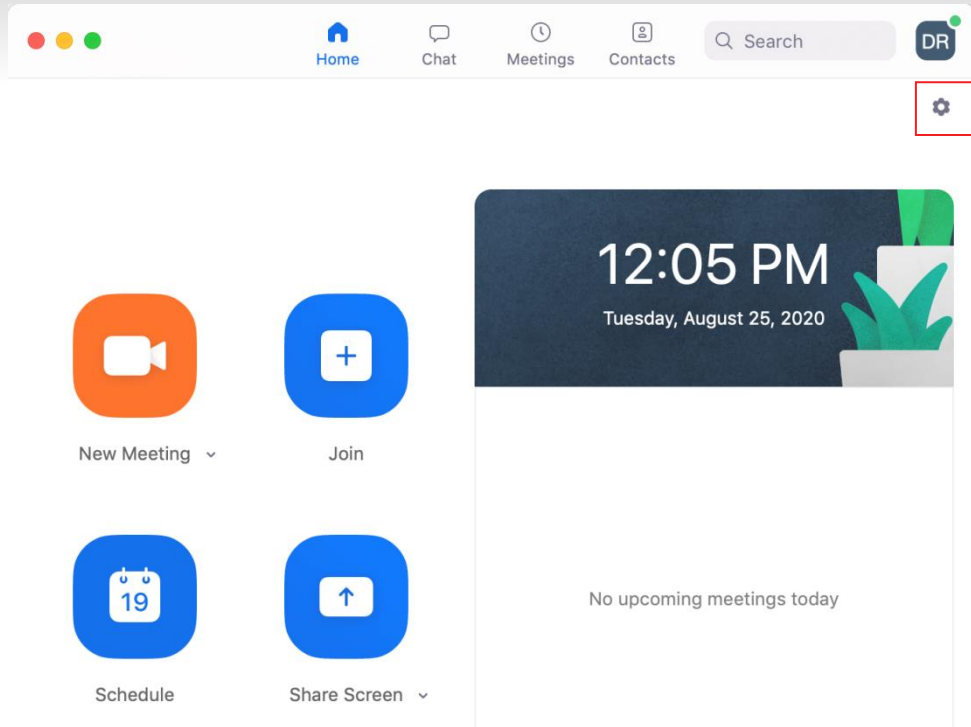


4. Navigate to "Background & Filters", click on the "+" symbol and choose Add Image.

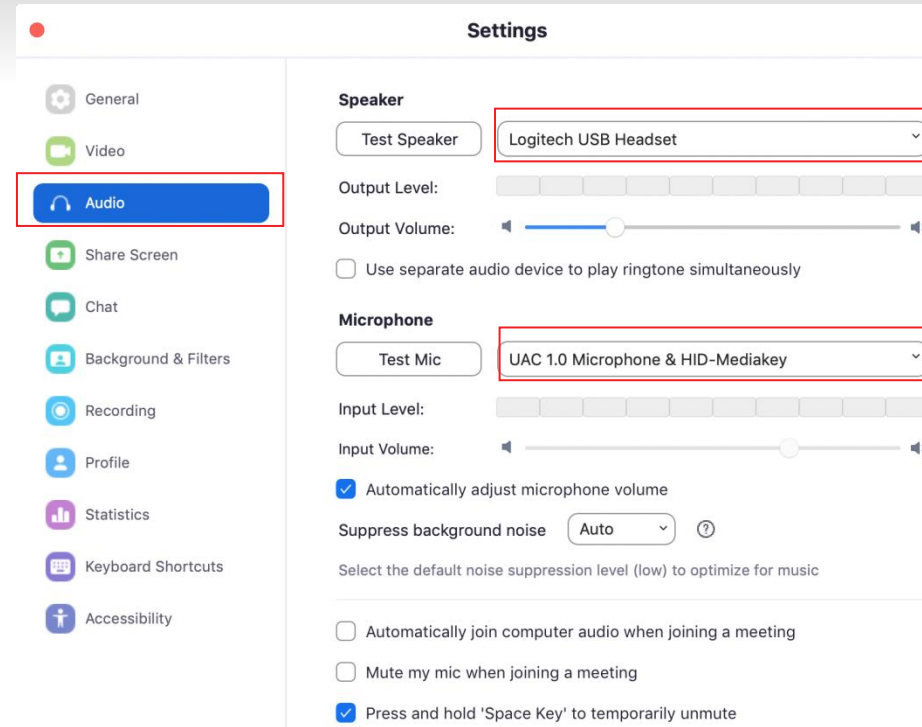


5. Select the appropriate "Virtual Background" file located on the documents folder and select open.
