  - b. \*IMPORTANT\*: ensure suction cup is clean and free of any debris.
- 3. The Video Conference Light box contains a USB-C to USB-C cable. Connect cable to Lume Cube and any available USB-C ports on either side of laptop. Press and hold the blue power button to turn the device on.










Adjust Brightness and Color
